Pacing Requirements and why they are important?

- We carry the same pacing requirements as FLVS. If your student does not
 maintain their pace, then no matter if FLVS or SJVS will withdraw after no work
 or communication for (2) weeks. *If withdrawn, you can always reach
 out to your teacher and ask for re-instatement.
- Pacing consists of 2-4 (core courses) and 1-2 (elective courses) assignments completed weekly. This equates to 6% per week for the semester.
- This pacing is a bonus for it allows a check on your student to ensure courses are being completed and not carrying over into the next school year.
