

How to See Teacher in APEX Course

Please note how to see who your teacher is in APEX.

1. After logging in and adding your email and phone number, it is now time to see who your teacher is.
2. You can see who your teacher is for each class by hovering (do not click) over the Courses name (arrow #1 below)
3. When you hover, you will see a box above appear, click where you see the teacher's name (arrow #2 below)
