Progress Monitoring Session 1 (PM1)



Thank you so much for all your hard work and support during our first progress monitoring session. The window officially closes on September 30^{th.} This week we will be progress monitoring our 9th and 10th graders in ELA and continuing to complete our make-up progress monitoring sessions.



The same platform, but a different purpose. While the appearance is the same, the purpose is totally different. This is now a progress monitoring tool, an adaptive formative that covers the standards within the subject or grade level for the entire year. Please **do not worry** if your student's score does not reflect previous end of the year assessments. We know **our students are amazing** and **will rock the 3rd progress monitoring session!**



Our 2nd progress monitoring session will be at the beginning of **December for grades K-5**, and the middle of **January for grades 6-10**. This progress monitoring session (PM 2) will also be for an informational purposes. During this PM 2 Session, students should see an improvement of their baseline score and be made aware of the standard that will require more instruction in order to show mastery on the final PM3 session.



In the end, by conducting these progress monitoring sessions, the teachers will be able to use the data collected to focus their instruction to best meet the needs of their students.
