
- SJVS does not provide computers, printers, or internet.



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Sign Up for Courses



SJVS incorporates Florida Virtual School (FLVS) curriculum and then provides the instructors. We ask, when registering, if there is an option to take with either SJVS or FLVS, please always choose SJVS.

Why Choose SJVS?

- 1. With SJVS you are guaranteed to be placed within 24 hours after approval from your school counselor and based on your preferred start date.
- 2. Teachers are all Highly Effective and live in St. Johns County and are full-time employed with St. Johns County School District.
- 3. Work to create a pace that sets your child up for success. It is never in the best interest of a student to be in a semester course over the 18 weeks or in a year course past the school calendar. This ensures that a student remains on track to advance grades or meet graduation requirements.

If you wish to take a virtual course for credit recovery, please meet with your school counselor.

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

COURSE STRUCTURE

GRACE PERIOD

Part-time or Home Education



First 21 days is a trial period

Should be actively working in courses

End of 21 days a student should be roughly 18% complete



Withdrawing from course


During grace period = No penalty

After 21 day grace period = WP of WF

Pacing

- · Submit assignments on time.
- Submitted work will be graded within 2 school days.
- Failure to adhere to your pace chart could result in withdrawal from the course.
- A general guide is to complete 6% of your course each week.

 However, the pace chart is the most accurate reflection of whether or not you are on pace.
- · Course work for the week is due by 5PM on Fridays.
- Completing your segment is a marathon, not a sprint. Pacing yourself will help you complete the race!

Discussion Based Assessments (DBAs)

Share What You Know

During the DBA you will have the chance to share what you learned in the module and to verify your mastery of the concepts!

Complete In Order

The Discussion Based Assessments are typically located at the end of each module before the module test. Complete them BEFORE moving on to the next module.

Mandatory

DBAs are a **required** part of the course. You may not skip them, be excused from them, or take a zero.


Use Your Notes

You may remediate assignments to review the content and improve your grade.


NO resubmissions will be allowed after you take your exam.


Once you have submitted ALL assignments, including DBAs, you will receive clearance giving you permission and the password to take your exam.

Courses

- Credit Recovery
- New Core Courses (prescriptive courses are being retired)
- Not meant for First-time credit
 - Should not be going through here. If there are unique situations where your admin is asking, they must submit the request directly to Dawn Sapp.

Tutorials

- Grade Forgiveness
- ACT/SAT Prep
- Great extra resource
- Best used for struggling students you identify after a quarter
 - Adaptive Based digs down to where the gap is and helps close

ROLE OF SCHOOL COUNSELOR

SJVS Counselor

- Only advises full-time SJVS students
- Does not verify courses outside of SJVS full-time
- Communicates any changes with SJVS to district counseling team

B&M Counselor

- Verify transcript
- Verify if SJVS offers course (try to keep funds in SJCSD)
- Approve course
- Monitor student engagement
- Completed course, print email record
