A "Discussion Based Assessment (DBA)" is a time for the students to share something they learned in the module with the teacher. Students are required to talk with the teacher via phone/ZOOM to complete this assignment each module. Students may use notes but should not receive any additional support from another person (parent, guardian, tutor, sibling, friend, etc.).

DBAs can be completed in multiple ways:

- using the appointment calendar on the homepage of the class
- using the open DBA times listed on the homepage of the class
- joining the live lesson for the module review and DBA (shown on the pace chart) (If students use this option, the student is required to speak substantially during the meeting)
