- What is School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - o required document that outlines goals to address school needs
 - o developed by school leadership team
 - o goals are based on data including parent/staff/student surveys, state testing data, teacher requests for programs etc.
 - SAC is available to advise the principal but the principal has the final decision on all components of the School Improvement Plan
- How does SIP impact SAC
 - o School Improvement Plan (SIP) is driving force of all SAC decisions
 - o Principal must present finalized SIP to SAC team
 - Each school will have Areas of Focus. These are goals for the year that should also be SAC's focus
 - o All funds requests must align with Areas of Focus addressed in the SIP

SAC Funds

- SAC has two district accounts (SAC program 102 and School Recognition Funds program 805)
- SAC treasurer or SAC chair should communicate with school bookkeeper and report the account balance monthly
- moies from these accounts must be used for actions to implement the SIP including non-recurring expenses for educational equipment or temporary personnel to assist in improving student performance.
- $\circ\quad$ funds requests should be submitted at least one week prior to the meeting
- "a portion of funds provided in the annual General Appropriations Act for use by school advisory councils must be used for the school improvement plan". SS 1001.452 District and School Advisory Council
 - these monies may be used on programs/projects selected by SAC
 - funds not subject to override by principal or district staff

- funds can not be used for capital improvements or projects that last more than one year
- funds roll over into the following year
- School Recognition Funds
 - o Funds awarded to schools who receive a school grade A, improve at least one letter grade or improve more than one letter grade and sustain the improvement the following year
 - funds awarded by the commissioner of education usually for the amount of \$75 \$100 per full time student
 - o funds are usually distributed in winter of the following school year
 - o staff and SAC must decide how to use financial award as per statute must be
 - non-recurring faculty and staff bonus
 - non-recurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials
 - temporary personnel to assist in maintaining or improving student performance
 - o if staff and SAC can't reach an agreement by Feb 1, the award must be equally distributed to all classroom teachers currently teaching at the school
