A “Discussion Based Assessment (DBA)” is a time for the students to share information they learned in the module with the teacher. Students are required to talk with the teacher via phone/ZOOM to complete this assignment each module. Students may use notes but should not receive any additional support from another person (parent, guardian, tutor, sibling, friend, etc.).

DBAs can be completed in multiple ways:

- using the appointment calendar on the homepage of the class
- using the open DBA times listed on the homepage of the class
- completing the Nearpod AND speaking substantially during the live lesson for that week
