### **DBA Information:**

A “Discussion Based Assessment (DBA)” is a time for the students to share what they have learned in the module with the teacher. Students may use notes, but should not receive any additional support from another person (parent, guardian, tutor, sibling, friend, etc.).

DBA requirements are based on enrollment status:

<b>Student Type</b>	<b>DBA Requirement</b>
<b>Full-time</b>	Must complete the module 4 DBA via live phone call. The module 2 DBA will be exempted if student is in good academic standing (At least a “B” average).
<b>Flex</b>	Must complete all DBAs. DBAs will be via live phone call.
